

New year's greetings from District 4. Hope your holidays were Merry and Bright and you have wonderful memories tucked away with the Christmas decorations.

Every year our district is invited to play our old time tunes for the Central Point Presbyterian Church while they serve a wonderful turkey dinner to about 200 members of the community. The musicians who come and play are in turn fed. It's no surprise this is a favorite gig and usually there is no shortage of musicians.

Plans for the December Jam were to honor our Lifetime and National Treasure members but do to illness and a cold, rainy day many members couldn't attend. Pre-registering is very simple – check out the various options mentioned on the registration form. Register now so you won't have to remember to do it later!

If you're entering the Entertainment Showcase, please be sure to <u>read the rules</u> pertaining to this division and ask me if you have any questions. See Section 6 under Article III of the Bylaws – <u>there's a link on the OOTFA.org website</u>. Other than your accompanists, you may have one other fiddler perform with you in this division. There is a place on the registration form for the name of the fiddler performing with you. Also, for clarification, a fiddler can appear only once in this division and the two fiddlers performing together will share any prize money & trophy.

This month we head into the back woods of Kentucky for a beautiful A-modal tune that comes to us from Bruce Greene, perhaps the best-known collector and performer of old Kentucky tunes.

You can hear Bruce play it (and download it free) on <u>Slippery Hill.</u> (While you're there, give Larry Warren a little donation to cover his costs of maintaining <u>slippery-hill.com</u>) And of course some nice renditions on YouTube, including one by <u>Foghorn</u>, and one from <u>The Balers</u>, winning first place at a Clifftop band competition. (Note that Bruce doesn't play it as fast as these guys!)

If you cross tune, this is usually played in cross-A tuning (AEae) This tune can be played with just the I, IV, and V chords (A, D, and E in this case)
