Tune of the Month Thanks to Joe Ross of District 10 for this month's tune

This waltz was played by Ozarks region fiddlers including Lonnie Robertson, Bob Holt, Glenn Rickman and Monte Stephens. Some Ozarks fiddlers either moved to the Northwest or lived there for long periods of time. Commonly played at fiddle contests in the 1960s, the waltz was recorded on the influential 1969 "Waltz Wonderland" LP by Loyd Wanzer. It's also on Canadian fiddler Don Messer's 1978 "40 Years On" LP (listed as "Ozark Mountain Waltz"). Washington State fiddlers like Joe Pancerzewski and Gil Kiesecker played it. District 10 offers this notation, written by Marge Tonge, from the playing of Pancerzewski. It was published in the Washington Old Time Fiddlers newsletter in 1984.
